CONSERVATION EFFORTS: NATURE SEEKERS COORDINATES BEACH CLEAN UP

Trinidad's beaches are globally important nesting sites for leatherback sea turtles. As part of our tourism and conservation initiative, Nature Seekers annually cleans and promotes conservation at the Matura Beach nesting.

For the past 25+ years Nature Seekers Annual Beach Cleanup has created an opportunity for citizens of Trinidad & Tobago to assist in conservation efforts, to protect endangered sea turtles. Over the years the number of participating volunteers has increased with numbers as much as 2000. On the day of the event, volunteers are divided into teams led by Nature Seekers' staff members. Debris and litter are collected and sorted: glass for repurposing, wood for burning and/or composting, and everything else for disposal.

Recognizing the vital role that beaches play in our ecosystem, our cleanup aims to conserve these valuable resources, raise awareness about environmental issues, and foster responsible tourism. The event serves as a platform to educate participants on the importance of reducing waste, recycling, and protecting marine ecosystems, reinforcing the idea that individual actions can make a substantial impact on our planet's health.

CONSERVATION EFFORTS: NATURE SEEKERS LEAD BEACH CLEAN UP CONT'D

Preparation for the beach cleanup at Matura required meticulous planning and coordination by the dedicated Nature Seekers team. This involved:

- Securing necessary permits and permissions from local authorities
- Preparation of site and infrastructural support systems for the event activities
- Procuring cleanup equipment such as gloves, trash bags.
- Liaising with stakeholders for the provisions of services such as emergency response and garbage disposal.
- Organized educational exhibits facilitated by our guests and collaborators.
- Invitation of local and community service providers and artisans.
- Promoting the event through social media and email newsletters

The team worked tirelessly to ensure that all logistical aspects were in place to facilitate a safe and productive cleanup day which entailed several team meetings and internal coordination.

We were honored to have several distinguished guests and exhibitors present at the cleanup event. Their presence added value to the event by providing expert insights, showcasing innovative solutions, and demonstrating their commitment to environmental stewardship. Our guests and exhibitors included, but were not limited to; the El Socorro Centre for Wildlife Conservation, the Environmental Management Authority, Forestry Division, IamMovement along with Close the Loop, the Adopt a River Programme, the Disaster Management Unit attached to the Sangre Grande Regional Corporation, SpeSeas, Hydrastation, Turtle Village Trust, H.E.R.O.E.S and JT's Car Rentals.

This year's cleanup event at Matura attracted a significant number of participants from diverse backgrounds, ranging from students and families to environmental enthusiasts and corporate volunteers. Their collective efforts resulted in a substantial amount of trash being removed from the beach, contributing to a cleaner coastal environment and a more conducive habitat for our nesting sea turtles.

Nature Seekers continues to value every contribution made by our citizens, partner organizations and collaborators. We are eternally grateful for their support and assistance. CRUISE SEASON

JEWEL OF THE SEAS MAKES FINAL CRUISE CALL FOR THE 23/24 SEASON

The Jewel of the Seas made its final call to the port of Port of Spain for the 2023/2024 Cruise season earlier today with 2,562 visitors representing approximately 30 nationalities on board.

Cruisers from the United States of America accounted for more than 2,000 of those passengers. Over 600 visitors enjoyed pre-packaged tours to key tourist attractions like the Maracas waterfalls, a city tour and then to Maracas Beach or Mt St Benedict, kayaking on the Caroni River and a Paramin 4x4 adventure. A total of 39 maxi taxis transported visitors to the various sites that showcase the island's history and natural beauty.

The Jewel of the Seas made 19 calls to the port of Port of Spain for the 2023/2024 Cruise season bringing an estimated total of 46,219 passengers to Destination Trinidad. The Ministry of Tourism, Culture and the Arts expresses gratitude to the Jewel of the Seas for choosing Trinidad and Tobago as one of its preferred destinations for the 2023/2024 Cruise season. We look forward to welcoming the cruise line and its passengers to the destination again for Cruise Season 2024/2025.

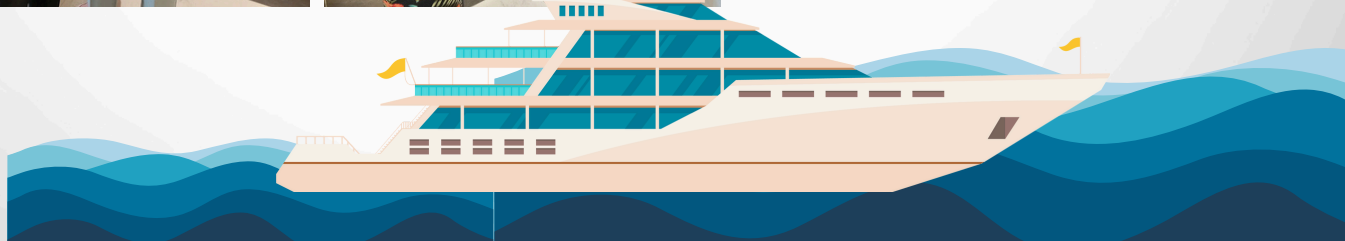

Tourism Trinidad is currently pursuing marketing initiatives in the Dutch market with KLM Royal Dutch Airlines. Based on KLM flights into Port of Spain three (3) days per week, the overall goal is to achieve an increase in the number of visitors flying into Trinidad utilizing the KLM's Amsterdam's, Schiphol Airport hub. This is the third busiest airport in Europe and is an excellent gateway with worldwide connectivity to the GAS markets (Germany, Austria, Switzerland), Asia, Africa and the Middle East.

Our Co-op Marketing for 2024 includes the following activities to assist with increased passenger throughput on KLM's service into POS as well as increased visibility and knowledge of the destination to a diverse audience thus attracting potential visitors:

1. KLM Flying Dutchman

The Flying Dutchman is a quarterly magazine sent to 140K Flying Blue Elie members, BluBiz and corporate customers and has a reach of approximately 270K readers. Our advertorial can be seen in the March print edition and we will be featured in the online version in June which is sent to 750K Flying Blue members.

2. KLM Bus Wrap

The KLM bus wrap is a destination advertisement which will be placed on 2 buses for 4 weeks in May or June 2024, which is a daily free service for KLM passengers travelling to and from the Schiphol airport from regions in the Netherlands.

3. KLM Sales Campaign

The KLM Sales Campaign is a communication with a discounted fare via email marketing to a database of 1.8M subscribers and Destination Trinidad will be mentioned on the campaign page of KLM.nl. scheduled for June 2024.

4. Jij & KLM

This is an inspirational platform for KLM's 3K travel agents in the Dutch market. Destination Trinidad is highlighted with an article on the Jij & KLM website this month and also scheduled for September 2024.

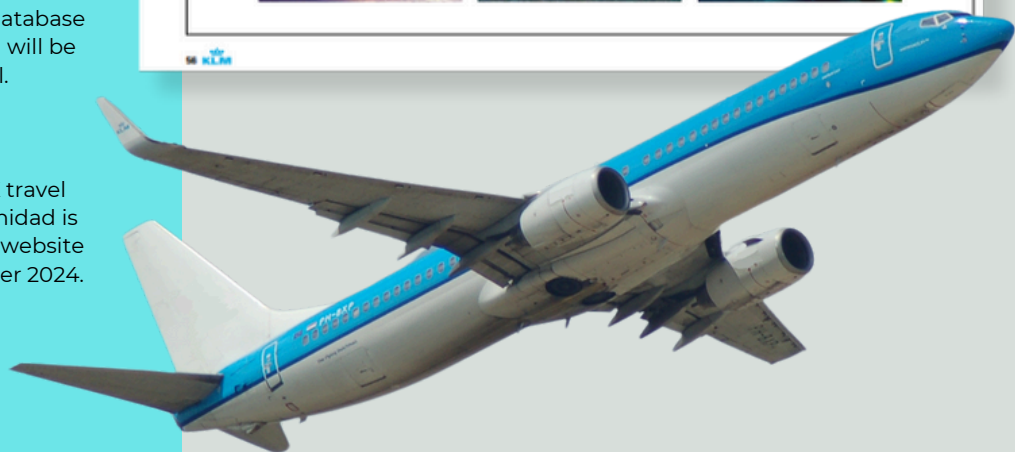

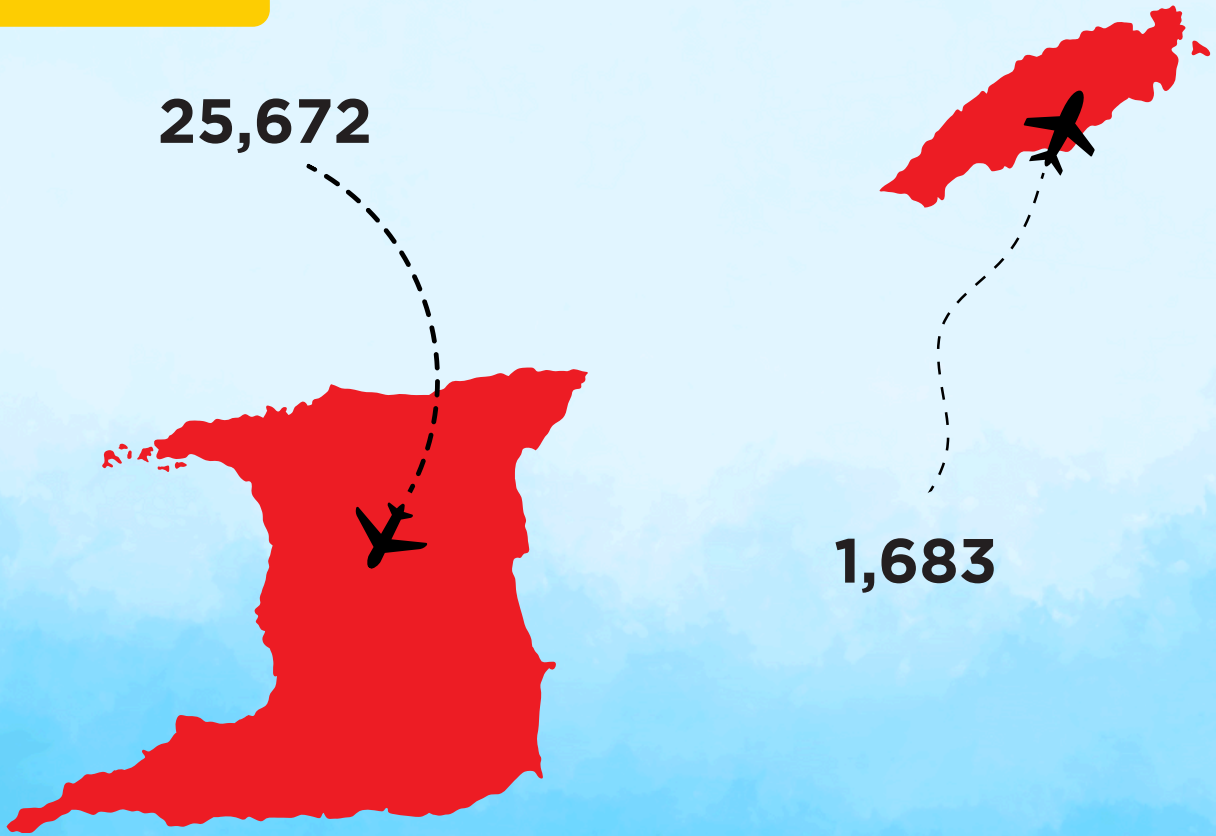

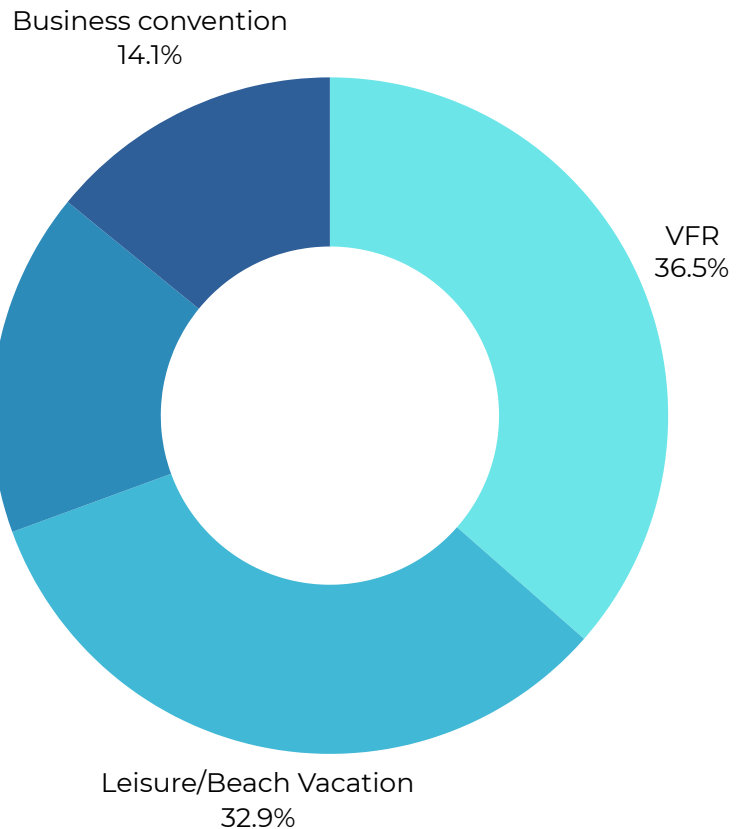


ARRIVALS BY SOURCE MARKETS
