Indian Heritage Month in Trinidad and Tobago is celebrated annually in May, marking the arrival of the first Indian indentured labourers to the island on May 30, 1845.

In commemoration of this historic event, the National Council for Indian Culture of Trinidad and Tobago (NCIC) hosted their 2024 Heritage Festival at the Divali Nagar in Chaguanas from May 4 - June 1.

Within the month in question, a series of activities were planned that showcased our country's vibrant East Indian cultural traditions, art forms, and culinary delights. Some of the events that were held included a heritage month food festival, a night of traditional chutney music, Indian traditional dance performances, an artisan market, an Indian inspired art exhibition and a grand show that included all of the aforementioned elements.

The objective of the activities were to emphasize the importance of preserving and cherishing the diverse traditions brought to our beautiful Caribbean islands by our Indian ancestors. Indian Heritage Month also intends to promote an appreciation of the impact of Indian culture to our modern day society amongst the wider population and to visitors alike.

TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO AND THE STATE OF QATAR SIGNS AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT



On Thursday, May 23, 2024, Senator the Honorable Rohan Sinanan, Minister of Works and Transport, and His Excellency Jassim Saif Al Sulaiti, Minister of Transport, signed a bilateral air services agreement between the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and the State of Qatar that would see a new era of travel, as it is set to promote greater connectivity and increased accessibility between the two States with the commencement of non-stop or one-stop services.

Other than further growing our local aviation, tourism, and trade industries, this strategic decision also presents the opportunity to strengthen diplomatic, cultural, and educational ties between Trinidad and Tobago and the State of Qatar.

While in Qatar, the Airports Authority of Trinidad and Tobago also received a commemorative award that recognized the role that our national airports have played in helping to foster improvements in the areas of safety aerodrome operations, supporting airport staff, and ensuring the safety of passengers.

PROTECTING OUR OCEANS

THE INSTITUTE OF MARINE AFFAIRS





The Institute of Marine Affairs (IMA) is mandated to conduct interdisciplinary research focused on coastal, marine, and environmental studies in Trinidad and Tobago. Established under the provisions of an Act of Parliament, the IMA has been operational since 1978. Its primary mission is to provide scientific research and advice for the sustainable management of the nation's coastal and marine resources. The organization plays a pivotal role in advising the government on policies related to these areas and aligns its activities with national development plans and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The IMA operates through five main research programs:

- 1. Biodiversity and Ecology: Conducts research on wetlands, coral reefs, benthic communities, and invasive species. Projects include long-term monitoring of coral reefs and seagrass communities to assess environmental impacts such as climate change.
- 2. Fisheries and Aquaculture: Focuses on fisheries biology, aquaculture, and marine turtle conservation. Research supports sustainable fishery practices and explores mariculture as a means of economic diversification.
- 3. Oceanography and Coastal Processes: Research areas include oceanography, sedimentology, coastal dynamics, and engineering. Projects like the Coastal Conservation Project monitor beach dynamics and impacts on coastal development.
- 4. Environmental Quality: Monitors water and sediment quality in coastal and marine environments, assessing pollutants and their effects to support pollution reduction strategies.
- 5. Geomatics: Supports research with Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and Remote Sensing, contributing to projects such as spatial data management for watershed monitoring and the development of the Caribbean Marine Atlas for Integrated Coastal Zone Management.

Through these programs, the IMA aims to generate scientific data and recommendations that inform national policies, contribute to sustainable development goals, and promote the conservation and responsible use of Trinidad and Tobago's marine resources.
